Prize Entry Fee: \$7.00 +HST per head in single classes and \$7.00 +HST per group. (Fees must be received by Entry Closing Date. Make cheques payable to "NSPE")

Copy of insurance must accompany this form.

Rules, Regulations & Show Information

- Sheep will be housed in the Agridome
- Deliveries must be made prior to 10:00AM via the Ryland Avenue entrance, and vehicles must be parked in the exhibitor parking lot.
- Exhibitor's passes will be distributed through the SPANS office and each exhibitor will be contacted with details.

This pass includes:

- 1 free 3-day pass (Friday through Sunday) per exhibitor
- 1 delivery pass per exhibitor
- Sheep must be in pens by 10:00AM, August 24, 2018 and will only be permitted to leave the grounds after 5:00PM, August 26, 2018
- Breeding classes will be judged on Sunday, August 26, 2018, commencing at 1:00PM.
- All sheep, whether owned by one person or by more than one person (individually, or jointly) are considered to be the production of farm breeding unit on which they are maintained.
- All exhibits must have completed present Pedigree.

Number of Exhibits per Breeding Unit

The maximum total eligible exhibits from a breeding unit are 5 head per breed per Exhibitor or breeding unit.

Please Note: Exhibitor must own all animals. There will be no refund of entry fees for sheep unless the Exhibition Office is notified 48 hours prior to designated arrival time. All exhibits in the Sheep Division must be clean and presentable.

Prize Money

The maximum prize money to be paid is \$30.00 per head. <u>If entries exceed the money per head, the prize will be reduced.</u>

Section "P" North Country Cheviot

Section "Q" Any Other Breed

Animals must be shown in short fleece (staple less than one inch). Animals will be checked for wool length prior to show and rules will be strictly enforced. Wool breeds may be shown in full fleece as long as they are clean and presentable. Prize money will not be paid for any animal that does not comply.

#	Class Name	Description
1	Ewe - Yearling	3 rd pair of temporary incisors must be in place
2	Ewe - Lamb	1 st pair of temporary incisors must be in place

Championship Class Structure

The overall winners of Classes #1 and #2 for each section will compete for Champion & Reserve. The champion will receive a \$50.00 cash prize; the reserve will receive a \$25.00 cash prize.

Breeding Class Structure

#	Class Name	Description
3	Ram - Yearling	3 rd pair of temporary incisors must be in place
4	Ram - Lamb	1 st pair of temporary incisors must be in place

Championship Class Structure

The overall winners of Classes #3 and #4 for each section will compete for Champion & Reserve. The champion will receive a \$50.00 cash prize; the reserve will receive a \$25.00 cash prize.

Breeding Class Structure

#	Class Name	Description
5	Breeders Flock	Bred and owned by the exhibitor

- A group of four animals, both sexes are to be represented
- Each animal in the group must have been exhibited in one of the preceding classes
- ALL ANIMALS IN A GROUP ARE TO BE OF ONE BREED

Championship Class Structure

The overall champion flock of Class #5 will receive a \$100.00 cash prize.

MARKET LAMB SHOW

Market Lamb Class Structure

#	Class Name	Description
1	Heavy	100-125 lbs
2	Medium	75-99 lbs
3	Light	74 lbs and under

- Lambs must be presented in full fleece. Market Lambs will be sheared and clipped 5:00PM August 25^{th.}
- Weighing will take place 10:00AM August 26th
- Only one animal per class per breeder. Market lamb is open to ewes and rams.

Championship Class Structure

The overall winners of Classes #1, 2 and 3 will compete for Champion & Reserve.

SHOWMANSHIP

#	Class Name	Description
1	Junior Showmanship	15 years old and under
2	Intermediate Showmanship	16-29 years old
3	Senior Showmanship	30 years old and up
