

Clostridium perfringens Type A vaccine

Do you have an urgent need for Clostridium perfringens Type A vaccine?

Clostridium perfringens type A has been associated with lambs that succumb to an enterotoxaemic condition known as yellow lamb disease and with enterotoxaemic jaundice in cattle and sheep. Yellow lamb disease is characterized clinically by depression, anemia, icterus, and hemoglobinuria. Death of lambs within 24 hours of symptoms has been reported in Western Canada.





Emergency Access is available

With help from the Canadian Centre for Veterinary Biologics, Canadian Food Inspection Agency and the manufacturer, we have arranged access to a C. perfringens Type A vaccine. Although not registered for use in Canada, a batch of the vaccine can be imported into Canada for distribution by special permit to attending veterinarians.

In order to proceed with the import, we need to have a commitment from producers who need the vaccine, including the estimated number of doses needed this year.
