



### Definition of Terms

Ewe: A female sheep

Lamb: A sheep less than one year old

Ram: A male sheep

Wether: A castrated male sheep

Fleece: All the wool from one sheep Veterinarian: A doctor for all animals

including sheep

Forage: Grass and hay that sheep eat

Ruminants: Any animal that has four stomachs Grazing: Sheep eating grass when on pasture in the summer

Wool: Natural fibre from sheep, shorn and used for clothes, blankets, etc.

Hay: Grass, cut and dried in the summer and fed to sheep in the winter

Straw: Stalks from cereal grains, cut and dried and used for bedding in the winter

## What Do Sheep Need?

All living creatures need certain things to survive, like food, water, and shelter. For sheep what they need depends a lot on how old they are. Newborn lambs need colostrum and milk from their mothers, and lots of shelter from the cold. As lambs grow older they drink less milk and start eating more of the types of feed that they will need as adults. In the spring, summer, and fall most sheep are usually on pasture and eat grass. In the wintertime, there is no grass outside, so the sheep are fed hay. At certain times of their lives, sheep may need more nutrients that can be provided in forage. This might happen when they are still growing or when the ewes are producing milk for their lambs. In these cases they may be fed whole grains, such as barley or corn, or a concentrate ration. Concentrate rations include grain, minerals, vitamins, and, sometimes, a protein supplement. All sheep need clean water and some shelter from bad weather. Most farmers keep their sheep in barns during the winter. Because of their wooly coats, adult sheep only need shelter from the wind and don't mind cold temperatures. All sheep like having dry straw to lie on in the winter to keep them warm and clean. Farmers take care of their sheep to make sure they are healthy and comfortable. If any sheep are sick the farmer will treat them with the help of the veterinarian.
